Description of content: This Draft Uganda Standard applies to the tubercles of commercial varieties of lilac tannia grown from <i>Xanthosoma violaceum</i> Schott and white tannia grown from <i>Xanthosoma sagittifolium</i> (L.) Schott, of the <i>Araceae</i> family, to be supplied fresh to the consumer, after preparation and packaging. Tannias for industrial processing are excluded. Note: This Draft Uganda Standard was also notified to the TBT Committee.
