#### Addendum

The following communication, received on 16 December 2024, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the <u>United Kingdom</u>.

Amendments to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/2072

<u>G/SPS/N/GBR/67</u> of 10 September 2024 notified planned amendments to England, Scotland and Wales (Great Britain) assimilated legislation (Commission Implementing Regulation (EU)2019/2072).

Following further risk assessment, it has been decided to exclude all *Thuja* spp. from the notified measures on wood that are due to come into force on 30 January 2025. The import of wood of *Thuja* spp. will continue under the current requirements.
