- **Description of content:** New Zealand has amended the Import Health Standard for bovine germplasm which includes semen and *in vivo* derived embryos to expand the scope with new biosecurity requirements for *in vitro* produced embryos. Minor changes are also proposed for the existing import requirement. Worth noting are the changes for bovine genital campylobacteriosis in semen and lumpy skin disease in *in vivo* derived embryos.
