The list was established by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 2016/1141 and was updated by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 2017/1263, by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No (EU) 2019/1262 and by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No (EU) 2022/1203. The notified proposal for a draft Regulation adds further species to the list. 7.
