**NOTIFICATION OF EMERGENCY MEASURES***Addendum*

The following communication, received on 11 March 2025, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of France.

---

Order of 23 February 2024 suspending the entry and import into France, and the placing on the market in France, whether free of charge or in return for payment, of fresh fruits and vegetables from non-European Union countries that have been treated with a plant protection product containing thiacloprid. NOR: AGRG2405380A

Owing to the serious risks to human health that may result from dietary exposure to the active substance thiacloprid, the French authorities are extending, until the entry into force of the new European MRLs on 12 May 2025, the suspension on the entry and import into France, and the placing on the market in France, whether free of charge or in return for payment, of fresh fruits and vegetables from non-European Union countries that have been treated with a plant protection product containing thiacloprid and that may contain quantifiable residues of this substance.
