	The Codex Alimentarius provides general guidelines for food irradiation but does no specify the permitted packaging materials. Meanwhile, the US Food and Drug Administration has established detailed regulations and an approved list of packaging materials for use during irradiation of pre-packaged foods. Therefore, this proposed amendment is aligned with the FDA 21 CFR Part 179, Section 179.45.	g g
