  - 1. The genus *Bombus* and *Melipona* are included according to the Chapter of infestation with *Aethina tumida* (also known as small hive beetle, SHB) of the WOAH Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
  - 2. The radius of being free from SHB is shortened from 100 km to 50 km.
  - 3. The risk control measures when transferring bees into transport containers are listed.
