#### Addendum

The following communication, received on 27 June 2025, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

### Established Maximum Residue Limit: Pendimethalin

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for pendimethalin notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1590 (dated 28 February 2025) was adopted 25 June 2025. The proposed MRL was established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and is provided directly below:

MRL (ppm)<sup>1</sup> Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

0.1 Sunflowers (revised)(crop subgroup 20B)
