- **6. Description of content:** This Draft Uganda Standard specifies requirements and test methods for Electric Pressure Cookers (EPCs) for household use. This standard applies to EPCs operating at a maximum voltage of 250 V single phase Alternating Current (AC) and a maximum pressure of 140 kPa.
