- 6. **Description of content:** This Proposal seeks to amend the *Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code* to align the following maximum residue limits (MRLs) for various agricultural and veterinary chemicals so that they are consistent with other national regulations relating to the safe and effective use of agricultural and veterinary chemicals: Afidopyropen, Broflanilide, Difenoconazole, Dithiocarbamates, Emamectin, Imazamox, Imazapyr, Linuron, Propachlor, Pyraclostrobin and Tetraniliprole in specified plant commodities.
