Description of content: The draft Order proposes to establish a procedure for monitoring and reporting on antimicrobial resistance of zoonotic pathogens and commensal bacteria, as well as reporting, identifying their sources of origin, and eliminating discrepancies in distribution. Monitoring and reporting will cover the following bacteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Salmonella</i> spp.;• <i>Campylobacter coli</i> (<i>C. Coli</i>);• <i>Campylobacter jejuni</i> (<i>C. jejuni</i>);• commensal <i>Escherichia coli</i> (<i>E. coli</i>);• <i>Salmonella</i> spp. and <i>E. coli</i> producing enzymes such as extended-spectrum β-lactamases (ESBL), AmpC β-lactamases (AmpC) and carbapenemases (CP);• <i>Staphylococcus aureus</i>, methicillin-resistant (MRSA).

<p>They may cover commensal <i>Enterococcus faecalis</i> (<i>E. Faecalis</i>) and <i>Enterococcus faecium</i> (<i>E. Faecium</i>).</p> <p>This procedure will also apply to the selection of samples from cargoes imported into Ukraine.</p>
