Description of content: This decree amends Decree No. 10.419 of 7 July 2020, which regulates subparagraph "e" of paragraph 1 of Article 9 of Law No. 1.283 of 18 December 1950 and, in turn, amends Decree No. 9.013 of 29 March 2017 to provide for the <i>ante-mortem</i> and <i>post-mortem</i> inspection of animals.
