Description of content: The substance covered by the Act was authorised for a period of ten years as a feed additive for all animal species in the additive category 'technological additives' and in the functional groups 'binders' and 'anticaking agents'. An application was submitted for the renewal of the authorisation of this substance in accordance with article 14 of Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003. Based on the favourable conclusions of a scientific assessment of the dossier submitted by the applicant, conducted by the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), the authorisation of this substance as a feed additive for all animal species is renewed under certain conditions detailed in the Annex to the Act.

7. Objective and rationale: food safety, animal health, plant protection, protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, protect territory from other damage from pests.
