Description of content: The Order provides for approval of Requirements for milk, dairy products and spreadable fats intended for human consumption, produced in Ukraine or imported (shipped) into the customs territory of Ukraine, at all stages of their marketing. The Order establishes detailed requirements regarding: <ol style="list-style-type: none">the determination of the list of food products covered by this regulation, specifically raw milk, drinking milk, dairy products and spreadable fats, including butter, margarine, spreads and fat blends;all types of drinking milk;the definition of specific designations for dairy products and spreadable fats used in certain countries and languages;

<p>4. the labeling and presentation of food products. For example, the labeling of spreadable fats must indicate the fat content as a percentage;</p> <p>5. the procedures for verifying the declared fat content in spreadable fats.</p> <p>This Order also provides that milk, dairy products and spreadable fats that comply with the requirements of the legislation on safety and certain food quality indicators in effect prior to the entry into force of this Order, but do not meet all or specific provisions of the Requirements for milk, dairy products and spreadable fats approved by this Order, may remain in circulation until the end of their minimum shelf life or the expiration date (use-by date).</p> <p>The Order is also notified under the TBT Agreement.</p>
