6. Description of content: The draft Law of Ukraine "On Biocidal Products" is intended to regulate legal relations concerning the approval of active substances used in biocidal products, the state registration, production, making available on the market, placing on the market and safe use of biocidal products and treated articles. It also defines the rights and obligations of legal entities and individuals, as well as the powers of state authorities and their officials in the field of biocidal products. Specifically, the draft Law: • designates an authorized state entity to conduct the assessment of materials concerning the approval, renewal or review of approval of active substances, prepare expert conclusions on the approval, renewal or review of approval of active substances, and prepare expert conclusions on the possibility of state registration of biocidal products under a simplified procedure; • establishes the procedure and criteria for authorizing such entity, the duration of its authorization and the procedure for withdrawal of the authorization, as well as the procedure for determining the fees for the relevant services; • establishes requirements for laboratories conducting laboratory testing of active substances for the preparation of active substance dossiers, including accreditation requirements; • provides for the establishment of the State Register of Biocidal Products, which is to become operational on 1 January 2030, through the modernization of the existing State Register of Disinfectants. The draft Law also stipulates that all registrations of disinfectants that are valid as of the date of entry into force of this Law shall remain valid until their expiry.

The classification of biocidal products is set out separately in an Annex to the draft Law. This draft Law was previously notified in 2025 under the title "On Making Available on the Market and Use of Biocidal Products". The draft Law is also notified in accordance with the requirements of the TBT Agreement. The adoption of the draft Law will ensure a high level of protection of human and animal health and the environment against harmful organisms, such as pests or bacteria, as well as against the effects of active substances contained in biocidal products.
