Specifically, this Code is applicable to papaya that is field grown. It concentrates on microbial and chemical hazards and addresses physical hazards only in which can be related to Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) and Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) during primary production and minimal processing of the commodity.</p> <p>This Code does not provide recommendations on handling practices to maintain the safety of papaya at wholesale, retail, and food services or in the home.</p>
