Description of content: The objective of the notified document PMRL2015-49 is to consult on the listed domestic maximum residue limits (MRLs) for spinosad that have been proposed by the Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA). MRL (ppm) Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity 0.7 Bearberries, bilberries, cloudberries, lingonberries, muntries. partridgeberries 0.5 Aronia berries, buffalo currants, Chilean guavas, European barberries, highbush blueberries¹, honeysuckle, jostaberries, lowbush blueberries¹, native currants, Saskatoon berries (juneberries), salal berries, sea buckthorn, wild raspberries ppm = parts per million The MRLs are proposed to replace the currently established 0.5 ppm MRL for blueberries to reflect current terminology. 7.
