- 6. **Description of content:** The objective of the notified document PMRL2015-43 is to consult on the listed domestic and import maximum residue limits (MRLs) for clothianidin that have been proposed by the Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA).

- 0.8 Root vegetable (except sugar beet) (Crop Subgroup 1B)
- 0.7 Leafy greens (Crop Subgroup 4A)
- 0.45 Bulb vegetables (Crop Group 3-07)
- 0.4 Brassica (cole) leafy vegetables (Crop Group 5)
- 0.35 Leaves of root and tuber vegetables (Crop Group 2)
- 0.3 Tuberous and corm vegetables (Crop Subgroup 1C)<sup>1</sup>
- 0.02 Fat, meat and meat byproducts of cattle, goats, hogs, horses and sheep
- 0.01 Wheat

The MRL is proposed to extend the currently established 0.3 ppm MRL for potatoes to the remaining commodities in the crop subgroup.
