- **Description of content:** The regulatory measure authorises the commercialisation of eight substances as feed additives in the category of "sensory additives" following the re-evaluation carried out by the European Food Safety Agency (EFSA) in accordance with Article 10(2) of Regulation (EC)1831/2003. Appropriate protective measures are recommended as they have been considered as irritant to skin, eyes and respiratory tract.
