Description of content: This Draft resolution incorporates the following changes for the active ingredient L02 - LINURON from the Relation of Monographies of Active Ingredients of Pesticides, Household Cleaning Products and Wood Preservers: – Inclusion of new cultures (sweet potato, yacon potato, ginger, yam and cassava/manioc) with MRL of 1.0 mg/kg and safety security period "not determined due to the mode of use" for pre or post emergency use (application); and – Inclusion of coriander/cilantro and parsley cultures with MRL of 0.5 mg/kg and safety security period of 55 days for pre or post emergency use (application).
