- **6. Description of content:** The objective of the notified document PMRL2017-02 is to consult on the listed domestic maximum residue limits (MRLs) for sulfentrazone that have been proposed by the Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA).

MRL (ppm)¹ Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

- 0.4 Brassica, leafy greens (crop subgroup 4-13B)
- 0.2 Brassica, head and stem vegetable (crop group 5-13)²
- 0.15 Fruiting vegetables (crop group 8-09); Berries and small fruits (crop group 13-07); tree nuts (crop group 14-11); apples, mustard seeds (condiment type), mustard seeds (oilseed type), succulent shelled broad beans
