- **5. Title of the notified document:** Proposed Amendments to the Standards and Specifications for Livestock Products. **Language(s):** Korean. **Number of pages:** 28
- **6. Description of content:** The proposed amendment seeks to:
 - 1. Establish and revise the methods of egg washing and storage temperature requirement for shell eggs;
 - 2. Establish a provisory clause on the set point of shelf life of shell eggs;
 - 3. Modify phrase to clarify the set point of shelf life for mixed or simple processed products;
 - 4. Permit the distribution and sale of defrosted cheese and butter;
 - 5. Revise the methods of egg washing and establish the standard of storage for industrial eggs;
 - 6. Revise the standard of storage and usage for egg contents after egg breaking;
 - 7. Prohibit the centrifuging and crushing methods to obtain egg contents;
 - 8. Establish and revise the microbiological testing method;
 - 9. Modify the wording related to 'industrial egg' in the standards and specification for livestock products.
