Description of content: The Chilean National Fisheries Service and the Novartis Laboratory Chile S.A. have requested that lufenuron be included as a treatment for parasitosis caused by Caligus in salmonidae. In view of the toxicological nature of the product and European legislative history, it is proposed that Exempt Resolution No. 551 of 1 August 2014 be amended so as to include MRLs for lufenuron in muscle with skin attached.
