Description of content: The notified text amends Resolution No. 7214/2014 with a view to postponing, until 1 March 2015, the entry into force of the post-entry quarantine requirement for the following species: *Chrysanthemum frutencens* (*Argyranthemum frutescens*), *Chrysanthemum máximum*, *Chrysanthemum morifolium*, *Chrysanthemum parthenium*, *Cordyline* spp., *Hedera* spp., *Hydrangea* spp., *Ilex* spp. and *Nandina domestica*. This will enable ornamental plant companies to bring their processes into line with the measure.
