Description of content: The notification introduces the "Measures for the Supervision and Administration of Import and Export Food Safety (draft)", which are based on the <i>Food Safety Law of the People's Republic of China</i> and other food safety related regulations. The measures contain six chapters and 57 articles, including general principles; supervision and management of foods for import; supervision and management of foods for export; risk warning; legal liability; and supplementary provisions. They apply to inspection, quarantine and safety supervision and management of foods for import and export.
