- **6. Description of content:** The draft Regulation grants special guarantees to Denmark as regards *Salmonella* at import of broiler meat similar to the existing ones at import to Sweden and Finland. The prevalence of *Salmonella* in domestically produced broiler meat is very low in these countries and strict control measures apply. Therefore special guarantees are requested at import, which consist of testing for *Salmonella* spp. (with favourable result) of all consignments.
