If no, describe, whenever possible, how and why it deviates from the international standard: The current MRLs of 10 ppm in dried pepper and 5 ppm in raisin will be deleted because the MRL of 25 ppm in other solanaceous vegetables and 3 ppm in raw grapes have been set on the basis of the submitted data. MRLs in raw agricultural commodities apply to their processed commodities (including dried pepper and raisin) taking into account the processing factors (the JMPR estimated the processing factors of 7 for dried pepper and 3.91 for raisin). Therefore, the deletion of MRLs in dried pepper and raisin will not strengthen the current regulation, and all the proposed MRLs conform to the Codex MRLs.
