- 6. **Description of content:** Based on the OIE "Quarterly Aquatic Animal Disease Report (Asia-Pacific Region) April June 2017", White spot disease (WSD) and Acute hepatopancreatic necrosis disease (AHPND) are known to be present in Viet Nam. In addition, the SFDA technical team visited Viet Nam, observed the controls applied by the Vietnamese government for export facilities of fish and crustacean and other products of aquatic animal origin, and made recommendations. Therefore, the import of fish and crustacean and other products of aquatic animal origin from Viet Nam to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is temporarily suspended.
- 7. Objective and rationale: [X] food safety, [] animal health, [] plant protection, [] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [] protect territory from other damage from pests.
- 8. Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: The "Quarterly Aquatic Animal Disease Report (Asia-Pacific Region) April June 2017" shows that WSD and AHPND are present in Viet Nam. The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is instituting this emergency measure to prevent the introduction of WSD and AHPND into the country.
