Description of content:</b> The Republic of Korea is proposing to amend the "Standards and Specifications for the Food Additives": 1) The provision which is about application of pesticides MRL (Maximum Residue Limits) for food additives is newly established; 2) The specifications of the following four food additives are revised: Magnesium Silicate, Caffeine, Baking Powder, Mixed preparations; 3) The standards for the use of the following nine food additives are revised: Sodium Metabisulfite, Potassium Metabisulfite, Sulfur Dioxide, Sodium Bisulfite, Sodium Hydroxide Solution, L-Ascorbyl Palmitate, Sodium Sulfite, Sodium Hydrosulfite, Propylene Glycol.
