Description of content:</b> The Thai FDA is now proposing for adoption and endorsement by the Public Health Minister the proposed measure whereas all comments from stakeholders both inside and outside the country have been taken into consideration and the proposed measure has been modified as follows:  <i>Clause 1.</i> The expressions in Clause 8(13) of the notification of the Ministry of Public Health (No. 351) B.E. 2556 (2013), Re: Flavoured Milk, dated 26th June B.E. 2556 (2013), shall be repealed. The following expression shall be used instead. "(13) Coliform bacterial shall be detected not more than 10 in 1 ml. of pasteurized flavoured milk at manufacturing factory."  <i>Clause 2.</i> Manufacturers or importer of pasteurized flavoured milk which received Food Serial Number prior to the enforcement date of this Notification shall comply with requirements prescribed in this Notification within 1 year.  <i>Clause 3.</i> This notification shall come into force after 180 days as from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
