Fluoride (as F) is changed from "$\leq 10\text{mg/kg}$" to "$\leq 25\text{mg/kg}$". Lead(as Pb) is changed from "$\leq 4\text{mg/kg}$" to "$\leq 2\text{mg/kg}$". The standard is consistent with the actual condition of Chinese products.</p>
