- 6. **Description of content:** The Order bans the importation of domestic and wild pigs and their products, including pork meat and semen and immediately suspends the processing, evaluation of the application and issuance of sanitary and phytosanitary (SPS) import clearance for the said commodities. All shipments of the aforementioned goods into the country will be stopped and confiscated by all DA Veterinary Quarantine Officers/Inspectors at all major ports. Frozen pork meats from accredited establishments already in transit upon issuance of this Order are allowed to enter the country subject to veterinary quarantine rules and regulations.
- 7. Objective and rationale: [] food safety, [X] animal health, [] plant protection, [] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [] protect territory from other damage from pests.
- 8. Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: Based on news reports, pork products from Viet Nam brought into Chinese Taipei have tested positive for African swine fever (ASF) virus and there is a need to prevent the entry of ASF virus into the Philippines to protect the health of the local swine population.
