Description of content:** The Import Health Standard for Fresh Ginger for Human Consumption allows the importation of fresh ginger (*Zingiber officinale* and *Z. zerumbet*) rhizomes into New Zealand. The Risk Management Proposal describes the potential pests associated with the pathway in addition to justifying how those pest will be managed.
