Revise the limits for <i>Clostridium perfringens</i> in 'Soy sauces and pastes', 'Salted and fermented seafood products', 'Hot pepper powder or shredded hot pepper' and 'Spice products';2. Revise the manufacturing and processing standards for jellies;3. Clarify and improve the application of the maximum residual limits of pesticides;4. Revise and establish the application principles for the maximum residual limits in livestock and fishery products;5. Revise the standards for food preparation in food service businesses;6. Revise the sampling and sample handling methods;7. Modify the lists of food ingredients by adding, deleting and combining food ingredients as necessary;8. Revise and establish the maximum residual limits of pesticides in agricultural products (81 pesticides including Deltamethrin);9. Revise the maximum residual limits in livestock and fishery products (ten residual substances including Lindan);10. Revise the General Test Methods.
