The species <i>Malus domestica</i> and its requirements are to be removed from section 4.3, Fruit trees, and replaced by: SPECIES: <i>Malus</i> spp. CERTIFIABLE PLANT PATHOGENS: ' <i>Candidatus</i> Phytoplasma mali' <i>Cherry rasp leaf virus</i> <i>Erwinia amylovora</i>
