The Veterinary Conditions for Importation of Pasteurised Shell Eggs is a set of conditions established to facilitate trade in pasteurised shell eggs. This set of conditions is developed with reference to the Veterinary Conditions for Importation of Table Eggs. The veterinary conditions for Importation of Pasteurised Shell Eggs are as attached with this notification.
