However, the certificates printed with old watermark which are on the stock of the Provincial Directorates of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry shall remain valid until 31 of December 2021.

After 31 December 2021, only new watermarked Plant Health Certificate and Re-export Plant Health Certificate will be valid and the validity of the certificates with old watermark will expire.
