- **6. Description of content:** The proposed amendments seek to:
  - 1. Permit irradiation of seasoned dried fish/shellfish for the purpose of sterilization;
  - 2. Adopt statistical concepts (three-class attributes plans) for microbiological specifications for twenty food types including noodles, sauces, etc.;
  - 3. Establish and revise maximum residue limits for pesticides:
    - Establish maximum residue limits for newly registered pesticides (oxathiapiprolin, indaziflam, isoxaflutole);
    - Revise maximum residue limits for pesticides in 32 agricultural products;
    - Establish maximum residue limits for deltamethrin and fenpyrazamine in ginseng;
  - 4. Establish and revise maximum residue limits for veterinary drugs in foods:
    - Establish maximum residue limits for twenty six veterinary drugs in porcine muscle;
  - 5. Revise general testing methods.
