The Draft Implementing Decision is a routine update of that list, as changes made to the Combined Nomenclature of the Common Customs Tariff, clarifications requested by member States' veterinary and customs authorities, changes in the animal by-product legislation and alignment with the CN codes contained in TRACES need to be taken into consideration to ensure harmonised import controls at Union borders.
