Description of content:</b> The Draft provides for the addition of the Common list of plant quarantine objects of the Eurasian Economic Union approved by the Eurasian Economic Commission Council Decision No 158 of 30 November 2016 with the tomato brown rugose fruit virus (ToBRFV), the pepino mosaic virus (PepMV), the tomato spotted wilt virus (TSWV) and for the addition of the Common quarantine phytosanitary requirements for quarantine products and quarantined objects on the customs boarder and the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union approved by the Eurasian Economic Commission Council Decision No 157 of 30 November 2016 with requirements for quarantine products in relation to these viruses.
