## Addendum

The following communication, received on 1 February 2021, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

Established Maximum Residue Limit: Trifludimoxazin

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for trifludimoxazin notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1350 (dated 3 November 2020) was adopted 26 January 2021. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

- <u>MRL (ppm)<sup>1</sup></u> Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity
- 0.01 Legume vegetables (succulent or dried) (crop group 6), citrus fruits (crop group 10) (revised), pome fruits (crop group 11-09), tree nuts (crop group 14-11), cereal grains (crop group 15), annual canarygrass seeds, peanuts, eggs; fat, meat and meat by-products of cattle, goats, hogs, horses, poultry and sheep; milk
- <sup>1</sup> ppm = parts per million

An MRL is established for each commodity included in the listed crop groupings in accordance with the *Residue Chemistry Crop Groups* webpage (<u>https://www.canada.ca/en/health-canada/services/consumer-product-safety/pesticides-pest-management/public/protecting-your-health-environment/pesticides-food/residue-chemistry-crop-groups.html</u>) in the Pesticides and Pest Management section of the Canada.ca website.

MRLs established in Canada may be found using Health Canada's *Maximum Residue Limit Database* (<u>http://pr-rp.hc-sc.gc.ca/mrl-lrm/index-eng.php</u>) on the *Maximum Residue Limits for Pesticides* webpage (<u>https://www.canada.ca/en/health-canada/services/consumer-product-safety/pesticides-pest-management/public/protecting-your-health-environment/pesticides-food/maximum-residue-limits-pesticides.html</u>). The database allows users to search for pesticides or for food commodities.
