However there are no Codex MRLs listed for cyprodinil in or on leaf petioles (CSG 4B), pomegranates, globe artichokes, guavas, head and stem <i>Brassica</i> (CSG 5A), or pistachio nuts according to the Codex Alimentarius Pesticide Residue in Food website.</p>
