6.	Description of content: According to the announcement of the Government Gazette dated 22 January 2021, the suspension for importation of live domestic and wild pigs and their carcasses from Viet Nam has expired on 22 April 2021. However, the OIE has reported a continued outbreak of African Swine Fever in area of Viet Nam. Therefore, it is necessary for Thailand to prevent the entry of African Swine Fever disease into the country. By the virtue of Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation of live domestic and wild pigs and their carcasses from Viet Nam is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days after publication in the Thai Royal Gazette (21 May 2021).
