Description of content: The objective of the notified document PMRL2021-16 is to consult on the listed maximum residue limits (MRLs) for picarbutrazox that have been proposed by Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA). <u>MRL (ppm)¹</u> <u>Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity</u> 0.01 Dry soybeans, eggs; fat, meat and meat byproducts of cattle, goats, hogs, horses, poultry and sheep; field corn, milk, popcorn grain, sweet corn kernels plus cob with husks removed ¹ ppm = parts per million |
