The following communication, received on 10 June 2021, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the <u>United Kingdom</u>.

The Phytosanitary Conditions (Amendment) Regulations 2021

The proposal notified in G/SPS/N/GBR/7 has been adopted and published by the Phytosanitary Conditions (Amendment) Regulations 2021 (https://www.legislation.gov.uk/uksi/2021/641/made), laid before Parliament on 27 May 2021, amending the retained Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/2072 to introduce measures against pests *Agrilus bilineatus* and *Neocerambyx raddei*.

The Regulations will come into force from 22 June 2021 in Great Britain (England, Wales and Scotland) instead of 17 June 2021 as previously notified by G/SPS/N/GBR/7.
