Burm. f. and hybrids thereof;</li> <li>b) Persian limes grown from the species <i>Citrus limon</i> (L.) Burm. f. and hybrids thereof;</li> <li>c) Mexican limes grown from the species <i>Citrus aurantifolia</i> (Christm.) Swingle, also known as sour limes and key limes and hybrids thereof;</li> <li>d) Indian sweet limes, Palestine sweet limes grown from the species <i>Citrus reticulata</i> Blanco), including satsumas (<i>Citrus unshiu</i> Marcow.), clementines (<i>Citrus clementina</i> hort. ex Tanaka), and common mandarins (<i>Citrus deliciosa</i> Ten.) and tangerines (<i>Citrus tangerine</i> Tanaka), grown from the species <i>Citrus sinensis</i> (L.)
