6. Description of content: MPI proposes a change to the testing requirement for *Pepino mosaic virus* in the specific requirements for tomato (*Solanum lycopersicum*) in the Import Health Standard: Seeds for Sowing (155.02.05) to require that:

seeds are officially tested, on a representative sample of a minimum of 3,000 seeds officially drawn according to the ISTA or AOSA sampling methodology, using an NPPO-approved ELISA or NPPO-approved PCR testing method and found free from *Pepino mosaic virus*. Currently, the testing requirement for *Pepino mosaic virus* for tomato seeds for sowing in the Import Health Standard: Seeds for Sowing (155.02.05) requires that "seeds are officially tested, on a representative sample, and using appropriate methods, and found to be free from *Pepino mosaic virus*."

The proposed amendment strengthens the measures for *Pepino mosaic virus* in the Import Health Standard: Seeds for Sowing (155.02.05) by making the testing requirements more prescriptive.
