Description of content:</b> The Draft provides for the establishment in the Common Sanitary-Epidemiological and Hygienic Requirements for Products Subject to Sanitary-Epidemiological Surveillance (Control) of the standards for medicinal product for veterinary use in food of animal origin. The standards have been developed based on the residue limits of medicinal product for veterinary use established by the international standard of the Codex Alimentarius Commission - CX/MRL 2-2018 and the regional standard of the European Commission - Regulation No. 37/2010 of 22 December 2009 on pharmacologically active substances and their classification regarding maximum residue limits in food of animal origin.
