Description of content: This draft provides for inclusion to the Common List of Quarantine Pests of the Eurasian Economic Union of 11 new quarantine pests: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Natal fruit fly (<i>Ceratitis rosa</i> Karsch);- Cucurbit beetle (<i>Diabrotica speciosa</i> Germar);- Western potato flea beetle (<i>Epitrix subcrinita</i> LeConte);- Emarginate ips (<i>Ips emarginatus</i> LeConte);- Monterey pine engraver (<i>Pseudips mexicanus</i> Hopkins);- Western cherry fruit fly (<i>Rhagoletis indifferens</i> Curran);- African armyworm (<i>Spodoptera exempta</i> Walker);- Sunflower fruit fly (<i>Strauzia longipennis</i> Wiedemann);- American dagger nematode (<i>Xiphinema americanum sensu stricto</i> Cobb);- Bricolense dagger nematode (<i>Xiphinema bricolense</i> Ebsary, Vrain & Graham);- Californian dagger nematode (<i>Xiphinema californicum</i> Lamberti & Blevé-Zacheo). Their introduction into the customs territory of the EAEU and their spread on it endangers the quarantine phytosanitary security of the EAEU member States.
