The placing on the market, processing or use of animal feed additives is prohibited unless: a) animal feed additives are not authorized by the European Union and are not listed in the Register under Article 7 defined by this rule; b) the conditions of use defined by this rule, including the general conditions defined in Annex N3 to this rule (unless otherwise provided by the authorization), and the authorization of the substance (substance) is protected; c) the requirements related to labelling defined by this rule are met. Draft is adopted under the Deep and Comprehensive Free Trade Area (DCFTA) agreement and was elaborated according to Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 September 2003 on additives for use in animal nutrition (Text with EEA relevance). 7.
